



# Why be accountable?




## Women and Adolescent Girls Participation and Empowerment is a foundational standard in the GBV Minimum Standards.



<b>FOUNDATIONAL STANDARDS</b> The three <b>Foundational Standards</b> are critical individually and also fundamental to the implementation of <b>all</b> the Minimum Standards; they must underpin all programme elements and actions.	GBV Guiding Principles


