

GBV Risk Mitigation in Cash and Voucher Assistance

This GBV-CVA Coordination Toolkit is a collection of handy tools to support humanitarian actors to mainstream Gender-based Violence (GBV) in Cash and Voucher Assistance (CVA). Field oriented and pragmatic, these tools have been developed based on requests from CVA and GBV practitioners and have been recently piloted in various contexts.

These tools can be used separately and in any order and are meant to be contextualised.

DO YOU PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN CASH ASSISTANCE (CVA)? These tools will support you to identify and mitigate potential GBV risks, enhance your programme accountability and increase the GBV/Gender sensitivity of your CVA intervention.

ARE YOU A GBV SPECIALIST? These tools will help you engage with the Cash actors in a pragmatic and concrete way and will support you in advocating for better GBV risk mitigation.

TOOL 9 Short induction for cash frontliners on basics of GBV risk mitigation and PSEA	6 slides (20 min)
